

My training includes 6 years of medicine in Mexico City at the Faculty of Medicine of the Anáhuac University and 4 years of specialty in General Surgery at the Adolfo López Mateos Regional Hospital ISSSTE . During my last year of training I completed a fellowship in advanced laparoscopy at Hospital Juarez Mexico, as well as a diploma in Pharmacoeconomics endorsed by La Salle University.

During my academic training, I had the opportunity to have international rotations, including at Jackson Memorial Hospital in Miami and George Washington University Hospital in Washington, D.C.

After completing my specialty, I worked in the institutional field at Adolfo López Mateos Regional Hospital for 2 years, as well as at ISEM Hospital La Perla, where I gained experience in trauma surgery.
